



The Flora of Chudleigh Parish

Compiled by Michel Ragody Hughes (2021, updated 2023)

The Parish of Chudleigh, which covers an area of approximately 24.5 square kilometres, offers a considerable diversity of semi-natural and man-made habitats influenced by such factors as geology, soils, elevations, aspect, climate, hydrology and historical and current land use and management practices. The diversity of habitats includes woodlands (ancient, secondary and replanted broadleaved, wet woodland and conifer plantation), scrub, hedgerows, heathland, arable farmland, grasslands (sown leys, improved, semi-improved and unimproved grassland and road verges), allotments, cemeteries and a churchyard, waste and disturbed ground, walls, former quarries, damp ground, ponds and watercourses (ditches, streams, Kate Brook, Bramble Brook and the River Teign). The lowest point of the Parish is at approximately 15m Above Ordnance Datum (AOD) by the River Teign downstream of Chudleigh Bridge with the highest point at approximately 246m AOD on Great Haldon. Perhaps not unsurprisingly, the diverse physical characteristics of the Parish have exerted considerable influence on the overall range of habitats and their associated diverse and extensive flora.

The following list of vascular plant species comprises all those species recorded since 2000, found growing in the ‘*wild*’, primarily within the publically accessible lands of the Parish as well as private land where access has been accorded. Species listed are those which may be considered to be *Native*, *Naturalised*, *Casual*, *Escapes* or of *Planted* origin. However, it does not include planted species found growing in private or public gardens. The nomenclature of species is the most recently accepted¹.

The following species status categories are here provided solely in a Devon context², namely *Occasional* (recorded in 31-100 tetrads³ since 1986), *Rare* (recorded in 10-30 tetrads since 1986) or *Very Rare* (recorded in <10 tetrads since 1986). All other species can be assumed to fall variously into the *Frequent*, *Common* or *Very Common* classes in a Devon context and, as such, are not specifically identified here⁴.

Plant species are listed by broad species group with both scientific names (in alphabetical order) and English names (standard recognised) given. The total number of species recorded⁵ by each species group is shown in the box below and numbers by Devon population status categories in the box on the final page. This should not be considered an exhaustive list of plant species to be found in the Parish. To position the total number of species recorded in the Parish in a wider Devon context, the average number of species recorded per tetrad in the County is approximately 200⁶.
